
## Grossword Puzzle

### 15th Sunday after Pentecost

Hello friends! Have you ever had someone do something or say something to you that was wrong or hurtful? Have YOU ever done or said something to someone wrong or hurtful? I think we've all done that and have had it done to us. It doesn't make our heart very happy, does it? Guess what...it doesn't make God's heart happy either.

In our Gospel lesson from Matthew, Jesus is with his disciples and his friend, Peter wants to know how many times he has to forgive others. Jesus' reply is "seventy-seven" or "seventy x seven"...in other words...Jesus says EVERY time.

In our church service, every Sunday we say a very familiar prayer called 'The Lord's Prayer'. Part of that prayer (and say it with me if you know it) is: Forgive us our sins (trespasses) as we forgive those who sin (trespass) against us. We ask God for forgiveness and we ask for the strength to forgive those who have hurt us. Because God forgives us, we should also forgive others.

Every time we come to God, God grants us grace and mercy. As followers of Christ, we are to do the very same thing. Sometimes, it's really hard to forgive someone and it may take some time to get over a wrong that has happened to us, but it's something that we can practice with our whole heart....not just with words.

Loving God, help me to practice forgiving others, modeling the grace and mercy of your Son, our Savior, Jesus Christ. Amen.
