
Ezekiel 17:22-24 Psalm 92:1-4, 12-15 2 Corinthians 5:6-10 Mark 4:26-34

Hellooo Friends! Have you ever seen a mustard seed? It's a teensy, tiny little seed and from that teeny seed, it can produce more than one BIG, HUGE mustard bush! Mustard bushes are weeds and they can take over a whole field of crops! But...the beauty of this weed is that it can provide shade for animals to take a rest from the heat of the sun. Birds can build a nest in this big bush and mama can make it a safe space to have her babies. All of this....from one teeny, tiny seed.

In our Gospel lesson from today, Jesus tells his disciples a parable about the mustard seed. Remember, a parable is kind of like a story within a riddle, but it makes his disciples think hard about what Jesus is trying to teach them. Jesus says "The kingdom of heaven is like a mustard seed." WE are like that mustard seed. Everything we do, even the teeny, tiny things can make a BIG difference. Even something as simple as a smile can help brighten someone's day. When we share the seeds of God's love with others, it makes God's kingdom even bigger.
