
Grossword Puzzle


Discussion Question: If Jesus approached you and asked you to follow him, would you be like the disciples who dropped everything and went?

Third Sunday after Epiphany

Hellooo friends! I'm going for some ice cream. Would you like to follow me? Wonderful! What if I said I was going to the bowling alley? Would you still follow me? Busch Gardens? Great! How about if I said I'm not sure where I'm going...would you still want to come along? It's easy to say yes if I'm going somewhere you like and you know where it is, isn't it?

In our gospel lesson from Mark today, Jesus was calling people to come and follow him. The people he called were fishermen. They caught fish for a living.
