



# A Note from the Food Pantry

The Food Pantry volunteers have been busy providing food to individuals and families in our community. The past several months we have seen a large increase in the number of people coming to our Food Pantry. We are providing food to approximately 400 people each month. The need for food is great due to raising costs of rent, gas, food, utilities, etc. The clients must make difficult decisions on using their limited funds to pay for rent, medicine, and other essentials. Our Food Pantry helps by providing food for their table.

At the start of COVID-19 pandemic, the Food Bank of Southeastern Virginia, and Eastern Shore (FBSEVA) in Norfolk did not charge food pantries for any of the food that we received. Our Food Pantry distributes USDA Food and non-USDA food (food that is donated, and we purchase with Food Pantry funds). Starting on 1 January 2023, the FBSEVA will start charging for non-USDA food that we order and receive from the Food Bank. The Chesapeake City Council donated \$1 Million dollars to FBSEVA to be used for providing food to Chesapeake food pantries. Once this money is spent, all Chesapeake food pantries will be paying for non-USDA food they order. Chesapeake has many food pantries that only distribute non-USDA food and I do not know how long this money will last.

In December, our Food Pantry will be distributing Christmas Food Baskets to approximately 30 of the households that come to our Food Pantry. This food is non-USDA food that we provide to them. **Some of the items that we could use to put in the baskets are:** 

- cans/packages of soup
  - stuffing mix
    - Jiffy mix
  - cake/brownie mixes
    - peanut butter
- Jelly (NO glass containers)
  - cans of pumpkin
- frozen turkeys or turkey breasts

Each Monday, we hear many of the clients say they are so thankful that our food pantry is open and for providing the food they need. These people depend on us to assist with their monthly food.

To provide food each Monday, we need about 10 volunteers to interview the clients, assemble the food, give the food to the clients, and maintain the records required by the Food Bank. In addition, on Fridays, we get our food order at the Food Bank and bring it back to the church. We are always looking for volunteers to help on Monday and/or Friday or be available to assist when we are short

**volunteers.** Please consider stopping by to learn more about this ministry at Grace or contact Rodney Haberkorn.
