The Hedgehog Concept

I shared last month that I am currently doing coursework to earn an Executive Certificate in Religious Fundraising. A lot of the foundation of the course is about being able to clearly articulate an organization's mission, vision, and values with compelling stories. The idea is that people are much more likely to donate (time, talents, and treasures) if they share your values and believe in your mission.

Jim Collins, author of "Good to Great and the Social Sectors," encourages non-profits to clarify their mission and then always stick to it, which sometimes means saying "no" to projects/ideas and sometimes even donations that don't align with the organization's mission. He offers the Hedgehog Concept (see infographic below) as a way of helping organizations stay focused on fulfilling their mission.

The same is true of our individual lives. When we can clearly articulate our mission, vision, and values and focus our resources (time/talents/treasures) in ways that line up with them, we are more likely to feel fulfilled and to accomplish our goals.

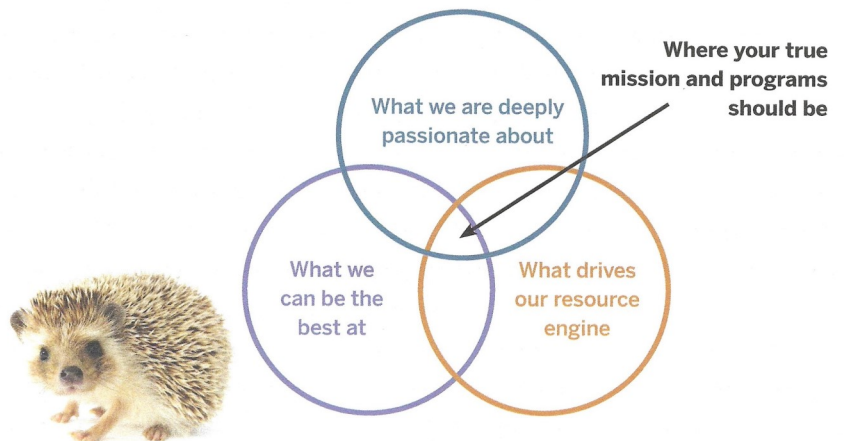
What activities/organizations that you are involved with line up with them? Which ones do not?

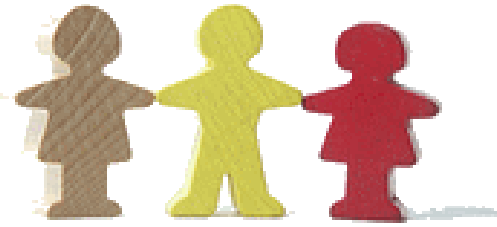

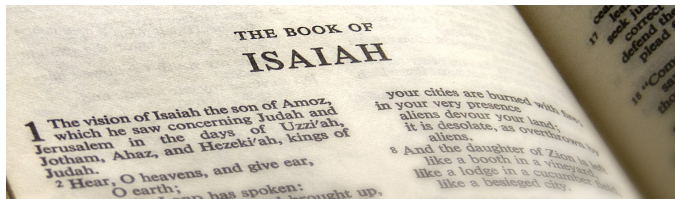
