Mission Statement:

We are a community of believers in Christ called to be servants to all people.

What Should We Be Giving?

Each week in worship, I say something along the lines of "everything we have is a gift from God, and we are called to use those gifts to do God's work in the world." I usually go on to say that financially supporting the ministries of Grace through a one-time or sustaining (weekly/monthly) gift is just one way to do that, but it is by far not the only way. There are so many organizations that you could support who do great work, whether they talk about that work in relation to God or not. Because there are so many options, it can be hard to choose how much and where to give.

Thinking about your charitable contributions in terms of a proportion or percentage of your total income can help keep things in perspective and really helps with budget planning. In the second week of "6 Weeks on Money," we were encouraged to choose how we allocated our money (see 3 options pictured)—what we were already doing or what we wanted to start doing.

Maybe you have never thought about your income this way before, but it helpful in making sure you don't live beyond your OPTION means and have savings when an emergency or other unexpected expense comes up. It can help us acknowledge that money is a tool/gift from God, but is not the end-all-be-all and therefore shouldn't have power over us.

The idea of giving 10% (a tithe) comes from the Bible (see Genesis 14:20, Genesis 28:22, Leviticus 27:30-32), but is never set up as an obligation in the New Testament. Actually, in the early church 100% giving to the community was expected (see Acts 4:32), but that is another story. However, the church continues to use 10% as a benchmark, a level of giving to N N O grow towards and even beyond. OPTI So, what SHOULD you be giving? There is SHOULD, no no set amount or percentage, but we are called to be generous in how we use God's gifts to do



- On Palm Sunday (April 10), during the late/traditional worship service, we will also sing "A Lamb Goes Uncomplaining Forth" (ELW #340) Read on to learn a bit about this hymn:

"[This hymn has been called] 'the model hymn of all Passion hymns'...Wolf Krötke, who spent time in an East German prison... [said of the hymn] '..."He will be a spring of water for my thirst, a companion with a word for my loneliness"-just for...[stanza 8, not in ELW], I love this hymn. "A companion with a word"-that means to me all words about our experience of God. They broaden the space that has been allotted us. They turned the couple of square meters in front of my wooden bench into the wide-open spaces in which God sets our feet'...Most congregants do not come from a prisoner's physical location, but the perspective of being closed in is known to everybody. Gerhardt's hymn...is about freedom in Christ." (Paul Westermeyer, Hymnal Companion to ELW, p. 135-6)

"Unlike the planet-based system in English, Spanish names the first day of the week for the Lord: domingo. Happily, the translation of this hymn makes the 'Lord's day' association clear, because much of what is valuable about this Latin American text is its celebration of this day's continuing significance...All the events narrated in the stanzas occur on the first day of the week: the women coming to the tomb, Mary Magdalene's being sent to tell that Christ is alive, the gathering of the disciples, [Thomas'] meeting with the risen Christ...the refrain declares good news to all. These examples are intended to affirm a great truth in the Easter message: 'Christ comes again, and every Lord's day." (Carl P. Daw, Jr., Glory to God: A Companion, p. 255-6)
