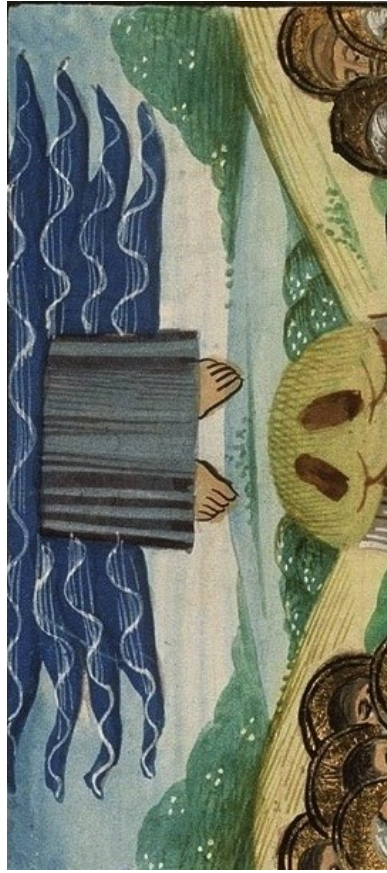


# “Grace Greetings”

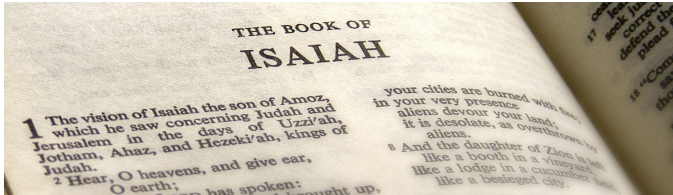

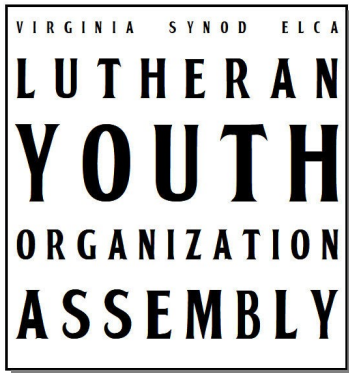


### Flea Market

**Kairos (VA Synod High School Youth Event)**  
**June 26 to July 1 at Roanoke College**

Kairos will be held from June 26 (Sunday evening) to July 1 (Friday noon) at Roanoke College. Kairos is our week-long faith formation event, offered each summer for youth who will be 9th-12th graders in the fall. Several times each day, we gather the whole Kairos group of about 175 youth and

adults for lots of singing and skits and fun and prayers, then participants gather in small groups that meet throughout the week. Kairos has many special features: event themed t-shirts, Open Talent Mic Show, faith testimonies, comic relief, reflection time, prayer stations, speed friending, t-shirt fashion show, and more! ("Kairos" is the New Testament Greek word for "special time." It is used whenever God's people want to talk about a time of change, of renewal, of God's special work in the believer and the community.)

This event is a chance for youth who are already committed to a life of faith to be part of a unique Christian community for an entire week, to have a fresh experience of the grace and presence of God in that community, and to develop habits for discipleship that can be taken home as they live out their baptismal call to be followers of Jesus.

### **Food Pantry Ministry**

The Food Pantry volunteers have been busy providing food to individuals and families in our community. We are providing food to approximately 250 individuals each month. The number of people coming to the food pantry is increasing each Monday. Through your generous donations of food and financial support we can distribute items that are not available through the Food Bank of Southeastern Virginia and Eastern Shore (FBSEVA) in Norfolk but are a staple of the client's food needs. These items include milk, bread, jelly, etc. We purchase these items at area grocery stores.

During January through April and using Thrivent Action Teams, we provided the food pantry clients with adult diapers, toothbrushes, toothpaste, wash cloths and bars of soap. These are items the clients need but may not have the available funds to purchase due to paying for rent, gas, medicine, etc.

Each Monday, we hear many of the clients



say they are so thankful that our food pantry is open and for providing the food they need. These people depend on us for their monthly food.

To provide food each Monday, we need about 10 volunteers to interview the clients, assemble the food, give the food to the clients and maintain the records required by the Food Bank. In addition, on Fridays, we get our food order at the Food Bank and bring it back to the church. We are always looking for volunteers to help on Monday and/or Friday or be available to assist when we are short volunteers. 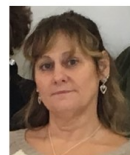

Bluebird Beach Bungalows are birdhouses made by people with disabilities to support people with disabilities. All profits are donated to charities selected monthly. The non-profit was started by Stephen Todd of Virginia Beach. The birdhouses are made from reclaimed wood, donated hardware, Chesapeake Bay treasures, and love. Since it's founding in 2018, Bluebird Beach Bungalows has donated over \$85,000 to over 60 different charities. Their mission is to "DO GOOD THINGS " with an emphasis on enhancing the lives of people with disabilities and preserving our environment. Read on to learn a bit about this hymn:

"Martin Luther's theology of holy communion is taught simply and profoundly in this hymn, one of the earliest hymns of the Reformation. Luther's text was inspired by an earlier hymn by Jan Hus, an early reformer and leader in the movement that would become the Moravian Church. Singing theology is an important part of the Lutheran tradition. It has a unique ability to form and strengthen a body of believers. Assemblies sing centuries-old music like this not because older things somehow have more intrinsic value, but because they have something profound to teach us. The communion of saints sings to us through these hymns as we join in "thankful labor" as Christ's body in the world. (from sundaysandseasons.com)
