
In our Gospel lesson from Mark this morning, we hear about people not working together very well. It was really crowded and people were saying some pretty mean things about Jesus...and then his mother and brothers tried to keep Jesus from doing his work! It was loud, noisy, and very chaotic. Jesus tells the crowd that a house divided against itself cannot stand, which is why Jesus tells them that they should listen to and follow the Holy Spirit.

Just like our car, lamp, and bath need other things to make them work well, we need God's Spirit in our lives to show us how to work well with each other. Jesus also says that whoever follows God is his family (his brothers, sisters, and mother). We call this great big family The Church. This is YOUR family, too! We are all related by the love of God through Jesus Christ and we remain a family by working together thanks to the Holy Spirit. When we all work together and follow Jesus' example, amazing things can happen!
