
Hellooo friends! Imagine that you were in the kitchen making homemade chocolate chip cookies. Your grow-up takes the cookies out of the oven, these warm, hot, gooey cookies, and tells you that you cannot have any. Your grown-up leaves the kitchen for a moment and you are left alone with those yummy cookies. Would you be tempted to sneak one?

In today's Gospel lesson from Mark, we hear that Jesus was whisked away into the wilderness just after he has been baptized. In the wilderness, the devil pays him a visit. Now, the devil is a trickster and wants Jesus' full attention, but Jesus worships only God. Mark's Gospel doesn't tell us what happened in the conversation between the devil and Jesus, but I'm sure that the devil was up to no good. No matter what the devil throws at Jesus, Jesus stays faithful to God. Jesus was able to stay strong because he was filled with the Holy Spirit and he was able to remember God's words from scripture.

In our liturgy, every week we say the Lord's Prayer and we pray, "Lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil." It's not always easy to do the right thing, is it? When we find ourselves tempted to do the wrong thing, we can remember that we, too, are filled with the Holy Spirit and we can think about God's words, just like Jesus did.

Loving God, help us to remember that you are bigger and stronger than the devil, who tries to trick us into doing things that we shouldn't. Fill our hearts with your words so that we can resist temptation. In Jesus' name, we pray, Amen.
