

#### **Mission Statement:**

#### Ministerial Fieldwork

In case you haven't heard yet, we are going to have a Seminary student joining us during this school year to complete her Ministerial Fieldwork! As the Seminary guidelines put it: "In Ministerial Fieldwork, the congregation and the supervisor share their congregational life with the student, and review and discuss the student's skills and gifts for ministry. Reflection on vocation—both the sense of purpose for the student in ministry, but also the corporate vocation, or 'call' that the congregation or ministry setting has received and faithfully engages—frames the Ministerial Fieldwork experience and themes throughout the year. In this way, Ministerial Leadership helps to prepare candidates for public offices of ministry, and particularly the endorsement stage of the second year of candidacy for ELCA students."

During her 12 weeks each semester, Seminarian Breezy will:

- Participate and assist in worship, education, & service ministries
- Initiate conversations with a wide variety of members/staff
- Teach and preach
- Interview congregational leaders/staff
- Study the congregation and its neighborhood
- At least once a month, have lunch with members of the congregation/agency
- Meet 6 times each semester with Supervisor for guided conversation around both the sense of purpose for the student in ministry, but also the corporate vocation, or 'call' that the congregation or ministry setting has received and faithfully engages.

Seminarian Breezy (she/her/hers) is a first year distributed learning student in the Masters of Divinity program at United Lutheran Seminary. She has received a positive entrance decision for Ministry of Word and Sacrament (Pastor) from the VA Synod Candidacy Committee.

She has been serving in ministry since her mid-twenties with different denominations. She passionately believes in holding open hands and preparing herself for whatever God

desires for her life in whatever role that means. She loves to serve people and be there for those intimate moments between God and God's creation. She is excited to be here to learn from the good people of Grace Lutheran.

She is a Virginia girl born in Hopewell, VA and finished high school at Western Branch High School in Chesapeake, VA. She grew up all over Virginia, going between the Appalachia, Tidewater, and Richmond areas of the state. She lives for the beach where she escapes too often to recharge and reflect. Seminarian Breezy loves to be outdoors as much as possible and she is a huge Star Wars nerd, enjoys loud music, coffee, and playing card and board games.

Speaking of students, Pastor Leslie will be supervising, and we are all encouraged to assist with the hosting of a Seminarian student from United Lutheran Seminary during this academic year. The purpose of this program is to help the student "articulate their faith in daily life, to take responsibility for worship, fellowship and decision making". Please welcome Brianna (Breezy) Riley the next time you see her, she'll be present for 12 Sundays each semester and will be participating in lunches with church members monthly. She is the future of ELCA Clergy so please make her welcomed.

The Employee Retention Credit application (ballpark of \$16,000) has been completed, sent, and received by the IRS. Now we have to be patient and wait for the processing which can take 6-8 months before the quarterly installments are received by Grace.

"Bridging the Gap"—the special giving campaign to help with our financial shortcomings is off to a great start and so far \$11,690 from 23 households and anonymous donors have been received.

Council will meet for a special brainstorming meeting to seek other financial ideas and opportunities to help balance the budget.

Upcoming Grace events include the semiannual community wide Flea Market on Oct 14. Proceeds from this event will go to defer the costs of transportation for our Seminarian. Please contact Millie Burns if you would like to rent table space or to volunteer with this worthy cause.

#### LUTHER SEAL

What does this mean?



Excerpts from Luther's interpretation...

#### THE BLACK CROSS IN A HEART

retains its natural color, so that I myself would be reminded that faith in the Crucified saves us. For one who "believes from the heart will be justified" (Rom. 10:10). Although it is indeed a black cross, which mortifies and which should also cause pain, it leaves the heart in its natural color. It does not corrupt nature, that is, it does not kill but keeps alive. "The just shall live by faith" (Rom. 1:17) but by faith in the crucified.

#### A WHITE ROSE

shows that faith gives joy, comfort, and peace. In other words, it places the believer into a white, joyous rose, for this faith does not give peace and joy like the world gives (John 14:27). That is why the rose should be white and not red, for white is the color of the spirits and the angels (Matt. 28:3; John 20:12).

#### THE SKY-BLUE FIELD

symbolizes that such joy in spirit and faith is a beginning of the heavenly future joy, which begins already, but is grasped in hope, not yet revealed.

#### A GOLDEN RING

around this field is a golden ring, symbolizing that such blessedness in Heaven lasts forever and has no end. Such blessedness is exquisite, beyond all joy and goods, just as gold is the most valuable, most precious and best metal. This is my compendium theologiae [summary of theology].
