A Shared Vision for Ministry with Pastor at 3/4 Time

In an effort to faithfully and effectively balance the ministry needs of the congregation and the available financial resources, the Council has developed the following covenant to guide our shared ministry when Pastor Leslie drops to three-quarter time starting January 1, 2024.

The congregation

* Will continue to:

- 1. Participate in the life of the congregation, in worship, ministry, and stewardship (time, talents, & treasures).
- 2. Look for the gifts of this season, and be patient when things aren't the way they used to be.
- 3. Take seriously their role in welcome of visitors and guests, and mutual care for one another. Notify Pastor of any special needs or changes, in your own household or that of another member/friend of Grace, that may require special care from the congregation.
- 4. As always, look for ways that the things they are good at and the things they love to do might enrich the common life or ministries of Grace; and affirm other members when they offer their gifts to the church.

* Will also need to:

- 1. Respect Pastor Leslie's part time job description by not expecting her to do everything she used to do in the way she used to do it when she was full time.
- 2. Open and close the building on Sundays.
- 3. Take the lead on Worship Server recruitment.
- 4. Fill gaps in all ministry areas, including but not limited to: Outreach, Fellowship, Visitation, Christian Education, Worship, Stewardship, Youth, Property, Communication, and Community Engagement.

Pastor Leslie

* Will continue to:

- 1. Be the Pastor of Grace Lutheran, Chesapeake
- 2. Preach and preside, or attend worship at Grace 75% of the time (minus vacation Sundays), striving to be present for all major holidays/occasions.
- 3. Work with the Minister of Music to plan worship, including lining up leadership (supply or lay) for Sundays away, and work with the secretary to produce bulletins.
- 4. Keep set Office Hours two days per week. (change from 4)
- 5. Attend Council and Preschool Board meetings.
- 6. Supervise staff and oversee communications with the congregation.
- 7. Receive prayer and pastoral care requests and either attend to them herself or coordinate response with the help of lay leadership.
- 8. Lead Monday Bible Study and resource leaders for Wednesday Night Bible Study.

- 9. Support and resource lay leaders for monthly and ongoing Outreach projects, including organizing Thrivent Action Team applications and reports.
- 10. Support and resource lay leaders, but not take any direct leadership role in Fellowship, Stewardship, Youth, Property, and other Projects/Events.

will no longer:

- 1. Preach and lead, or even attend worship at Grace 25% of the time (plus vacation Sundays).
- 2. Keep set Office Hours four days per week. (change to 2)
- 3. Take responsibility for opening and closing the building on Sundays.
- 4. Have any direct leadership roles in Sunday School, but will continue to support and resource lay leaders as needed.
- 5. Directly organize any monthly Outreach projects.

From the Council

Happy Advent to all Grace members as we prepare in our hearts, minds and souls for the coming of the birth of our Savior and Lord Jesus Christ.

Updates from our most recent Council meeting are as follows:

- The search for legal assistance to finalize transition from Trustees Incorporation status continues.
 - Starting in January, as voted upon at our last Congregational meeting, Pastor Leslie will begin her reduced status to that of three-auarter time. What does this mean to each of us? Most importantly we need to know that Pastor Leslie is still our Pastor but there will be duties she will no longer be responsible for and that we as members might and will need to step up in various functions of our church to continue its growth and community outreach. Opening closing the church on Sundays, recruiting worship servers and filling in gaps in all ministry areas are just a few of the upcoming areas in flux. Supply Pastors also will be utilized on off Sundays. A "3/4 Time Covenant" outlining what Pastor Leslie will and will not be responsible for and what the congregation will be asked to do is on page 2 of this

newsletter and there are copies available in the Narthex.

As we reflect on the past year and all the changes upcoming for 2024 know always that each and every member of Grace Lutheran are an integral and vital component of the body of Christ striving to daily live out our Mission Statement of being a community of believers in Christ called to be servants to all people.

This concludes my agreed upon year as President of the Council and I wanted to thank everyone for their support during this past year and pray that it is extended to your next President who will be elected during the next council meeting in January.
