Report from the Virginia Synod Assembly—June 9-11, 2023

Lutherans from all around the Virginia Synod gathered at Roanoke College for the 2023 Virginia Synod Assembly. The Synod welcomed **Deacon Sue Rothmeyer**, Secretary of the ELCA as our Churchwide Representative. The Assembly theme was The Way in the Wilderness. Hear the voice of the prophet Isaiah call out: "In the wilderness prepare the way of the Lord" (Isaiah 40:3a).





<u>Elections</u>

With the pending retirement of Bishop Bob Humphrey, the Assembly undertook the process of electing the next Bishop of the Virginia Synod. On the sixth ballot, the **Rev. Dr. Phyllis Blair Milton**, Pastor at Holy Communion, Portsmouth, was elected with 175 votes to 172 votes for the Rev. Kelly Bayer Derrick, Assistant to the Bishop of the Virginia Synod. Bishop-elect Milton will take office September 1. She will be installed as Bishop on Saturday, October 21 at First Presbyterian Church in Waynesboro.

The Assembly elected **Blythe Scott** (First, Norfolk) to serve as the new Vice-President of the Virginia Synod and elected **Judy Casteele** (Good Shepherd, Lexington) to serve as the Secretary of the Virginia Synod.

Elected to serve on Synod Council are Jillian Stierwalt (St. Andrew, Portsmouth), Christie McKee (Grace, Winchester), Christine Weller (Our Saviour, Williamsburg), Lily Harmison (Muhlenberg, Harrisonburg), and The Rev. James Armentrout (St. Mark's, Roanoke). Reelected to serve a second four year term are Carlton Hardy (St. Mark, Yorktown), The Rev. Phillip Martin (Epiphany, Richmond), The Rev. Monica Weber (Luther Memorial, Blacksburg), and the Rev. Harry Griffith (St. John, Norfolk).

Elected to serve on the Consultation Committee was **Debbie Mintiens** (Emanuel, Woodstock), **Glen Kirk** (Grace, Rural Retreat Parish), The **Rev. Scott Mims** (First, Norfolk), The **Rev. Matthew Diehl** (Mount Calvary, Mt. Jackson), The **Rev. JoAnn Bunn** (Gladesboro, Gladesboro), The **Rev. Sarah Hess** (Trinity, Moneta).

Elected to serve on the Committee on Discipline are **Dr. William Franz** (Christ, Richmond), The **Rev. Sherrie Hofmann** (Prince of Peace, Orkney-Basye), The **Rev. Karen Van Stee** (Grace, Waynesboro), The **Rev. Daniel Hess** (Trinity, Moneta).

Worship

The Assembly opened with a service of Holy Communion. Pastor Liz Radtke, Virginia Synod

Truth and Love Coordinator, served as the preacher for worship and focused on the Assembly theme, 'The Way in the Wilderness.' On Saturday morning, **Bishop Humphrey** presided at a service of remembrance for rostered ministers and former Synod leaders who had died in the last two years and also remembered congregations that had closed. Saturday's Assembly concluded with a Festival Service of Holy Communion that included commissioning eleven lay preachers **George Donovan**, **Laura Doughty**, **Janet Gomez**, **James Ingraham**, **Erich Lantz**, **David Mayersky**, **Sylvia Miles**, **Ray Riggin**, **Kristee Trumbo**, **Judith Wilfong**, **Leon Zimmermann**. The final day of the Assembly began with morning prayer and ended with a closing worship service featuring a sermon by **Deacon Emily Edmunds** (Chaplain, Virginia Baptist Hospital, Lynchburg) and the installation of those serving in leadership roles within the life of the Virginia Synod. This year the offering was designated to support the Lutheran Disaster Response and Virginia Synod Disaster Response.

Celebrations

We celebrated rostered minister ordination anniversaries, congregation anniversaries, lay leadership and five volunteers were recognized for the **2023 Serving Boldly Awards**. The award recipients were **Kisha Johnson** (Good Shepherd, Galax), **Carol Jones** (Christ, Richmond), **Robert Perry** (Zion, Edinburg Parish), **Diana Tiller-Dichtel** (St. Stephen, Williamsburg), and **Connie Watkins** (St. Mark's, Roanoke). We celebrated and honored Bishop Humphrey as he is concluding his term as bishop.

Assembly Business

The Assembly approved the 2023 and 2024 Investment in Ministry Plans, the 2021 and 2022 Synod Audits, and the Compensation Guidelines for 2024. Bishop Humphrey and the Officers of the Synod shared their reports and the Assembly heard from a variety of mission partners through ministry moment videos.

Nathan Rummel (Trinity, Newport News), president of the Lutheran Youth Organization, presented the Youth Assembly report, centered on the Youth Assembly theme of "Followers

of the Way and the Truth and the Life." He spoke to the immeasurable value of youth events, and also expressed the gathered youths' vision for the new bishop of the Virginia Synod. The next LYO Board president will be **Asher Porter** (Our Savior, Christiansburg).

From the Council

I don't know if it is just me, but June has flown by. Even though school is out and summer has officially begun, there is still a ton going on at Grace.

Throughout the summer, we will be holding a combined worship service at 9:45am each Sunday. Please join us in person or on 700m!

Sunday School is on hiatus, but Monday Bible Study (1:30pm on Zoom) Wednesday Potluck (6:30pm) and Bible Study (7pm onsite and on Zoom) continue throughout the summer (with just a few exceptions).

There are also many opportunities coming up for fellowship and fun!

We continue our year-round outreach ministries (Food Pantry, Book Ministry, Threaders, etc.) and our monthly emphases. Also, many community partners continue to utilize the building throughout the week for various programs and gatherings.

To continue all this good work in God's name, we need our shared resources time, talents, and treasures. At the end of May, we had spent over \$19,000 more than we had brought in. This is an average shortfall of about \$4,000 per month. We are also feeling some strain when it comes to volunteers as well; whether it is one-time worship server roles or ongoing positions on committees and boards, we are having more and more trouble getting people to volunteer.

So I want to ask you to consider giving more of your time, talents, and treasures. At Grace, we try to ensure that all the gifts that are entrusted to us by God are used to do God's work in the world—to be servants to all people, but no one of us can accomplish that in the same way as we all can together!

The Council is looking for ways to cut expenses, but there is not much to be cut without drastically changing our ministry, so we are hoping you are each able to step Please some way. qu volunteering for a new role or increasing your financial gifts in frequency or amount. Because of these realities, we had some heavy discussion topics at our June meeting.

We heard from the Sanctuary HVAC rehab team that there is no easy/cheap way forward, so for now we are simply giving thanks that for right now the repair that was made last summer seems to be holding. We will continue to work to plan for what the right next step is for when the two units do die.

We continue to work to bring all of our official documents (constitution, bylaws, deed, etc.) in line with the fact that we incorporated a couple of years ago. Bureaucracy is always fun!

We are looking into applying for the Employee Retention Credit.

We also discussed beginning a hiring process for a new nursery attendant, since Bella will be heading to college in August.

We decided to cancel VBS for this summer as time is tight, coordination was a little lacking, and we were short on volunteers.

As you might imagine, the hardest topic we discussed was the suspension of operation

of the Preschool for the summer and the 2023-24 school year, especially the \$16,000 that is owed to the Director.

Please plan to attend the Special Congregational Meeting after worship on Sunday, July 9th, where we will vote on a resolution to this problem.

As the official letter states (see next page), we hope that after some clean up work, we "will then as a congregation have the opportunity to dream about what additional ministry we might do with the resources that remain."

Despite all of these issues that can feel like a wilderness at times, we continue forward knowing that God is journeying faithfully with us through it all.

Thank you for all the ways that you continue to be faithful stewards and sharers of the gospel!

THANK YOU for your generous financial support of God's mission!

In **May 2023**, Grace Lutheran received \$13,610.21 in giving to the General Fund. Because of your generosity, we were able to:

- Hosted a Flea Market and raised money for Grace Preschool
- Welcomed Ethan into the church through Baptism
- Hosted a Red Cross Blood Drive
- Witnessed five youth affirm their faith and become adult members of the church

(to name just a few) with \$21,252.37 of expenses and generous gifts of time and talent.

Year to date (through May 31st), we have received \$73,595.47 for the General Fund and have had \$94,870.34 in expenses from the General Fund. The balance (as of May 31st) is \$42,232.90



Letter from the Preschool Board (June 14, 2023)

With deep regret, we write to inform you that the board of Grace Preschool has voted to not enroll students for Summer 2023 or the 2023-24 School Year. Due to low enrollment and financial strains, the preschool program is no longer viable in its current configuration.

The Preschool Board and the Congregational Council will work over the coming months to properly handle all legal and financial matters. We will then as a congregation have the opportunity to dream about what additional ministry we might

do with the resources that remain.

This is not something we expected to happen nor is it something we wanted. However, in order for us to be good stewards of the resources we have and to be faithful in caring for the staff, the children, and their families, it was ultimately necessary. We know that you may have a lot of questions and concerns. You are welcome to reach out to Pastor Leslie.

For 50 years, Grace Preschool has been a beacon of light in our Chesapeake community, and we are thankful for the countless students, staff, and volunteers that have been part of this ministry.
