


Object: A picnic basket

When I was a child, we sometimes had what we called, "All Day Preaching and Dinner on the Grounds." On that Sunday, people came to church carrying a picnic basket like this one. After church, we went outside and had dinner on the church lawn. There was fried chicken, mashed potatoes, fresh vegetables from the garden, and home-made cakes and pies of every kind.

That reminds me of a story about Jesus and his disciples. One day they got into a boat and sailed across a lake. When they reached the other side, they went up onto the side of a mountain and sat down to rest. A great crowd of people started coming toward them. They wanted Jesus to teach them and heal the sick and he did.

Soon it was time to eat. Jesus asked Philip, one of the disciples, "Where can we buy enough bread to feed all of these people?" Philip answered, "Eight months wages wouldn't buy enough bread for each person to have one little bite!"

Andrew, another disciple, spoke up, "Here is a boy with five small barley loaves and two small fish."


