


Crossword Puzzle

Sixth Sunday of Easter

Good morning friends! How many of you like to be by yourself? I do...sometimes. I like my quiet time to read and be with God and to sit with my thoughts. What do you do when you are alone?

In today's Gospel from John, Jesus' friends are all gathered together and Jesus is trying to explain to them that he must go and be with God. This news makes his friends sad because they do not want to be alone without Jesus. Jesus tells them that he is going to send someone to be with them. Jesus calls this "friend" an advocate someone who will always be with them and live in their hearts. This friend's name is the Holy Spirit.

When we are baptized, we receive the gift of this friend, the Holy Spirit, it is the very same Spirit that Jesus sends to be with his friends. The Spirit lives within us, guides us, and fills our heart with the love of Jesus so that we can pass that love on to all who we know. We are never truly alone because through the Holy Spirit, Jesus will always be with us.
